
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF AQUATIC RESOURCES, TO CONSULT AND CONFER WITH LICENSED SPECIALIZED FISHING PRACTITIONERS PRIOR TO IMPLEMENTING REVISED OR NEW REGULATIONS AFFECTING THESE STYLES OF NEAR-SHORE COMMERCIAL FISHING AND TO SEEK ADVICE FROM AND WORK COLLABORATIVELY WITH THEM ON ANY AND ALL FUTURE REGULATIONS RELATING TO COMMERCIAL FISHING.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii is special because of its past and many
2 traditions, cultures, values, and most importantly its people;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, as islands in the center of an ocean, the people
6 of Hawaii have and continue to rely on its natural resources as
7 a means for sustenance, health, culture and being; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the social, cultural and economic value of
10 Hawaii's natural resources have always been and will continue to
11 be immeasurable, unquantifiable and priceless; and
12

13 WHEREAS, whether facing times of economic challenge or
14 prosperity, food from the land and ocean fill a constant and
15 growing demand from locals of and visitors to our state; and

17 WHEREAS, specialized cultural practitioners, unique to
18 Hawaii, with intrinsic and learned knowledge passed down through
19 countless generations, trained, skilled, and proficient in
20 numerous techniques of fishing, including surround bag/gill net
21 fishing, fish trapping, and aqua lung and free dive spear
22 fishing, continue to demonstrate responsible use of and caring
23 for the bounties of the ocean by studying, nurturing,
24 cultivating, and managing these resources on a daily basis for
25 perpetual use; and


1 WHEREAS, these specialized cultural practitioners, the only
 2 providers of locally-caught fresh seafood to our State, are
 3 regulated by nature, the community, and the State, and accept
 4 their kuleana and responsibility to provide the Department of
 5 Land and Natural Resources with the only measurable and
 6 consistent source of data to record, interpret and analyze, and
 7 utilize as the best-available science in determining the
 8 condition of the resource; and

10 WHEREAS, as responsible experts of their trade and
 11 providers to our communities, these specialized cultural
 12 practitioners depend on the fair management of our resources for
 13 their livelihood and perpetuation; now, therefore,
 14

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 16 Twenty-fifth Legislature, of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 17 Session 2009, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources,
 18 Division of Aquatic Resources, is urged to consult and confer
 19 with these licensed specialized fishing practitioners prior to
 20 implementing revised or new regulations affecting these styles
 21 of near-shore commercial fishing and to seek advice from and
 22 work collaboratively with them on any and all future regulations
 23 relating to commercial fishing;

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 26 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Chairperson of the
 27 Board of Land and Natural Resources.
