
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CLASSIFY
KA IWI SHORELINE AS A STATE WILDERNESS PRESERVE.

1 WHEREAS, one of the visions of the East Honolulu
2 Sustainable Communities Plan is to preserve the Koko Head-
3 Makapuu scenic district, the area known as Ka Iwi; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the rugged coastal lands of Ka Iwi are among
6 Oahu's most unique and spectacular scenic resources, offering
7 views of mauka and makai from many vantage points; and
8

9 WHEREAS, protection of the scenic value of this treasure
10 has island-wide importance because of its attraction to both
11 residents and visitors; and
12

13 WHEREAS, preserving one of Oahu's most popular visitor
14 resources is critical to our economy and vital to attracting new
15 and returning travelers to the State; and
16

17 WHEREAS, nowhere else on the island, with the exception of
18 the Kaena coastline, as there elements of a natural environment
19 on one large, contiguous area of undeveloped open space; and
20

21 WHEREAS, overuse, misuse, and potential urban encroachment,
22 particularly in the Queen's Beach vicinity, are pressures that
23 threaten the integrity of this coastal area; and
24

25 WHEREAS, the State Office of Planning intends to file a
26 petition with the State Land Use Commission to reclassify the
27 Kai Iwi shoreline from an urban to conservation district; and
28

29 WHEREAS, state law requires that conservation districts
30 include areas necessary to preserve scenic and historic areas
31 and provide wilderness preserves; and

33 WHEREAS, by moving to classify the Ka Iwi shoreline as a
34 conservation district, or more expressly, a state wilderness




1 preserve, the area would be protected from any development or
2 construction; now, therefore,
3

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
5 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
6 of 2009, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is
7 urged to preserve and protect the Ka Iwi shoreline by
8 classifying the area as a state wilderness preserve in a
9 conservation district; and
10

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
12 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of
13 Land and Natural Resources, the Director of the Office of
14 Planning, the Chairperson of the State Land Use Commission, and
15 the Chairperson of the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board.



