
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES,
DIVISION OF CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT, TO
PROVIDE LIMITED ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AT NIGHT ON A REGULAR
BASIS AND TO CONTINUE PROVIDING ENFORCEMENT SERVICES ON
WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS AT KANEOHE BAY.

1 WHEREAS, Kaneohe Bay, located on the windward coast of
2 Oahu, is enjoyed by many island residents and visitors alike as
3 an area for swimming, fishing, water skiing, sailing,
4 snorkeling, scuba diving, jet-skiing, and boating; and
5

6 WHEREAS, on days of southerly winds and swells you can find
7 scores of boats being launched from Heeia Kea pier for a day of
8 fishing along the windward coast; and
9

10 WHEREAS, on holidays and weekends you can also find scores
11 of boaters partying on Ahu o 'Laka enjoying the sun and the sea;
12 and

14 WHEREAS, in the past, partying by boaters on Ahu o 'Laka has
15 resulted in confrontations between boaters due to intoxication,
16 causing serious injuries; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the community has lodged numerous complaints with
19 the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of
20 Conservation and Resources Enforcement (DOCARE), regarding the
21 fighting and excessive drinking on Ahu o 'Laka, and the abundance
22 of debris, including bottles, cans, and charcoal, left behind by
23 the boaters on Ahu o 'Laka; and

25 WHEREAS, other incidents involving boaters, snorkelers,
26 scuba divers, and other users have also occurred at Kaneohe Bay
27 on other days of the week; and

29 WHEREAS, at night, individuals are known to illegally take
30 marine life; and

1 WHEREAS, it has been rumored that DOCARE is planning to
2 suspend the provision of enforcement services on weekends and
3 holidays as a cost-cutting measure; and



5 WHEREAS, the enforcement services of DOCARE are necessary
6 at Kaneohe Bay despite the economic conditions, to ensure the
7 safety of bay users and proper enforcement of natural resource
8 laws and rules; now, therefore,
9

10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
11 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
12 of 2009, that DOCARE, is requested to provide limited
13 enforcement services at night on a regular basis and to continue
14 providing enforcement services on weekends and holidays at
15 Kaneohe Bay; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DOCARE is requested to adjust,
18 as necessary, the work schedules of its enforcement officers to
19 limit financial strain as much as possible, yet ensure the
20 provision of necessary enforcement services on weekends and
21 holidays, and at night on a limited basis; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
24 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Chairperson of the
25 Board of Land and Natural Resources.
