A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 266-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The director of transportation may also adopt, amend,
4 and repeal [~~such~~] rules as are necessary:

5 (1) For the proper regulation and control of:

6 (A) [~~all~~] All shipping, traffic, and other related
7 activities in the commercial harbors belonging to
8 or controlled by the State [~~, and~~];

9 (B) [~~of the~~] The entry, departure, mooring, and
10 berthing of vessels [~~therein,~~] in the commercial
11 harbors; and

12 (C) [~~for the~~] The regulation and control of all other
13 matters and things connected with [~~such~~
14 ~~shipping,~~] activities in the commercial harbors;

15 (2) To establish safety measures and security requirements
16 in or about the commercial harbors, land, and
17 facilities belonging to or controlled by the State;



1 [~~(2)~~] (3) To prevent the discharge or throwing into
2 commercial harbors of rubbish, refuse, garbage, or
3 other substances likely to affect water quality or
4 that contribute to making [~~such~~] harbors unsightly,
5 unhealthful, or unclean, or that are liable to fill up
6 shoal or shallow waters in, near, or affecting the
7 commercial harbors; and
8 [~~(3)~~] (4) To prevent the escape of fuel or other oils or
9 substances into the waters in, near, or affecting
10 commercial harbors from any source point, including,
11 but not limited to, any vessel or pipes or storage
12 tanks upon the land."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Department of Transportation; Harbors; Rules; Safety Measures

Description:

Authorizes the department of transportation to adopt rules relating to safety measures, security requirements, and shipping activities in commercial harbors controlled by the State.
