A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ATHLETIC TRAINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
as follows:
"CHAPTER
ATHLETIC TRAINERS
§ -1 Title. This chapter is known as the "Athletic
Trainer Licensing Act".
§ -2 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the
context indicates otherwise:
"Athletic trainer" means an individual who is registered
under this chapter and carries out the practice of athletic
training.
"Department" means the department of commerce and consumer
affairs.
"Directing physician" means a physician or surgeon or an
osteopathic physician or surgeon licensed under chapter 453,
who, within the licensee's scope of practice and individual
