### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HUMANE TREATMENT OF PET ANIMALS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§711- Confinement of a pet animal on public property.		
5	(1) A person commits the offense of confinement of a pet animal		
6	on public property if the person intentionally, knowingly, or		
7	recklessly confines a pet animal in a cage on public property		
8	for more than four hours, except to:		
9	(a) Restrain the animal for emergency purposes;		
10	(b) Prevent a threat to public safety;		
11	(c) Transport the animal to and from a veterinarian		
12	licensed under chapter 471; or		
13	(d) Allow the animal to participate in a show or exhibit		
14	operated by a bona fide, duly organized kennel club,		
15	breed club, or similar organization.		
16	It shall be an affirmative defense that the pet animal's

confinement was beneficial to the animal.

19		dogs', cats', or owner's health and well-being result
