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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$27,700,003 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010,  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh  
6 senatorial district, as follows:

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
12 improvement projects enumerated in section 1 of this Act shall  
13 not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the  
14 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the  
15 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as  
16 of that date.

17 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
18 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act  
19 shall be expended by:

20 (1) The department of water of the county of Kauai in the  
21 case of items 1 to 5;



1 (2) The county of Kauai, in the case of items 6, 8, 9, and  
2 10;

3 (3) The department of land and natural resources through a  
4 contract with the Kauai Public Land Trust, in the case  
5 of item 7; and

6 (4) Kauai community college, in the case of item 11  
7 for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
9 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$10,500,000 or so much  
10 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2010-2011  
12 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh  
13 senatorial district, as follows:

14 1. Hanalei water system

15 Hanalei school waterline improvements

16 Construction \$3,000,000

17 Total funding \$3,000,000

18 2. Wailua-Kapaa water systems

19 A. Kapaa storage improvements

20 Design and construct a new one

21 million gallon storage tank and

22 connecting pipeline





8 SECTION 5. The appropriation made for the capital  
 9 improvement projects authorized by section 4 of this Act shall  
 10 not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the  
 11 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the  
 12 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as  
 13 of that date.

14 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 15 capital improvement projects set forth in section 4 of this Act  
 16 shall be expended by the department of water of the county of  
 17 Kauai.

18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
