21 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 22 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



1 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
2 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
3 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
5 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
6 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as  
7 follows:

- 8 (1) For items 1, 2, 3, and 4 the expending agency shall be  
9 the department of transportation;
- 10 (2) For item 5 the expending agency shall be the  
11 judiciary;
- 12 (3) For items 6 and 7 the expending agency shall be the  
13 department of accounting and general services;
- 14 (4) For item 8 the expending agency shall be the  
15 University of Hawaii;
- 16 (5) For item 9 the expending agency shall be the  
17 department of human services; and
- 18 (6) For item 10 the expending agency shall be the  
19 department of agriculture;
- 20 (7) For items 11, 12, and 13 the expending agency shall be  
21 the department of education;





- 1 (8) For items 14, 15, 16, and 17 the expending agency
- 2 shall be the department of land and natural resources;
- 3 (9) For item 18 the expending agency shall be the
- 4 department of business, economic development, and
- 5 tourism; and
- 6 (10) For items 19 and 20 the expending agency shall be the
- 7 county of Hawaii.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
