# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to protect Hawai'i's  
2 natural resources and to promote collaboration among state  
3 agencies.

4           SECTION 2. Section 183C-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
5 amended by amending the definitions of "land" and "landowner" to  
6 read as follows:

7           "Land" means all real property, fast or submerged, and all  
8 interests therein, including fauna, flora, minerals, and all  
9 such natural resources, unless otherwise expressly provided[-],  
10 except land owned by a state department or its subdivision.

11           "Landowner" means an owner of land or any estate or  
12 interest in that land[-], except if the owner of land or any  
13 estate or interest in the land is a state department or its  
14 subdivision."

15           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.


