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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND MAKING  
AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE TWENTY-SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,850,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects.

6           SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
7 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
8 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
9 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
21 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
22 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.



1 For items 1 and 3, the expending agency shall be the  
2 department of land and natural resources.

3 For items 2 and 4, the expending agency shall be the  
4 department of transportation.

5 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital  
6 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
7 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
8 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
