4 improvement projects enumerated in section 1 of this Act shall
5 not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
6 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the
7 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as
8 of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
10 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act
11 shall be expended by:

- 12 (1) The department of education in the case of items 1 to
13 7; and
14 (2) The department of transportation, in the case of item
15 8.

16 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue
17 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$30,950,000 or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2010-2011
20 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
21 twenty-first senatorial district, as follows:


