# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FUNDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature determines that there is in the  
2 agricultural loan reserve fund at least \$                                 in excess of  
3 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
4 finance is authorized to transfer from the agricultural loan  
5 reserve fund to the general fund the sum of \$                                 or so  
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

7           SECTION 2. The legislature determines that there is in the  
8 agricultural loan revolving fund at least \$                                 in excess  
9 of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director  
10 of finance is authorized to transfer from the agricultural loan  
11 revolving fund to the general fund the sum of \$                                 or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

13           SECTION 3. The legislature determines that there is in the  
14 state risk management revolving fund at least \$                                 in  
15 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
16 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the state  
17 risk management revolving fund to the general fund the sum of

1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
2 year 2009-2010.

3 SECTION 4. The legislature determines that there is in the  
4 Hawaii election campaign fund at least \$ in excess of  
5 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
6 finance is authorized to transfer from the Hawaii election  
7 campaign fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so  
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

9 SECTION 5. The legislature determines that there is in the  
10 works of art special fund at least \$ in excess of the  
11 requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
12 finance is authorized to transfer from the works of art special  
13 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

15 SECTION 6. The legislature determines that there is in the  
16 stadium special fund at least \$ in excess of the  
17 requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
18 finance is authorized to transfer from the stadium special fund  
19 to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

21 SECTION 7. The legislature determines that there is in the  
22 wireless enhanced 911 fund at least \$ in excess of the

1 requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
2 finance is authorized to transfer from the wireless enhanced 911  
3 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

5 SECTION 8. The legislature determines that there is in the  
6 medicaid investigations recovery fund at least \$ in  
7 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
8 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the medicaid  
9 investigations recovery fund to the general fund the sum of  
10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
11 year 2009-2010.

12 SECTION 9. The legislature determines that there is in the  
13 state identification revolving fund at least \$ in  
14 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
15 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the state  
16 identification revolving fund to the general fund the sum of  
17 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
18 year 2009-2010.

19 SECTION 10. The legislature determines that there is in  
20 the hydrogen investment capital special fund at least  
21 \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund. On  
22 July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to transfer

1 from the hydrogen investment capital special fund to the general  
2 fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be  
3 necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

4 SECTION 11. The legislature determines that there is in  
5 the Hawaii community development revolving fund at least  
6 \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund. On  
7 July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to transfer  
8 from the Hawaii community development revolving fund to the  
9 general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be  
10 necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

11 SECTION 12. The legislature determines that there is in  
12 the housing finance revolving fund at least \$ in  
13 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
14 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the housing  
15 finance revolving fund to the general fund the sum of  
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
17 year 2009-2010.

18 SECTION 13. The legislature determines that there is in  
19 the rental assistance revolving fund at least \$ in  
20 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
21 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the rental  
22 assistance revolving fund to the general fund the sum of

1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
2 year 2009-2010.

3 SECTION 14. The legislature determines that there is in  
4 the rental housing trust fund at least \$ in excess of  
5 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
6 finance is authorized to transfer from the rental housing trust  
7 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

9 SECTION 15. The legislature determines that there is in  
10 the dwelling unit revolving fund at least \$ in excess  
11 of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director  
12 of finance is authorized to transfer from the dwelling unit  
13 revolving fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so  
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

15 SECTION 16. The legislature determines that there is in  
16 the compliance resolution fund at least \$ in excess of  
17 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
18 finance is authorized to transfer from the compliance resolution  
19 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

21 SECTION 17. The legislature determines that there is in  
22 the housing for elders revolving fund at least \$ in

1 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
2 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the housing  
3 for elders revolving fund to the general fund the sum of  
4 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
5 year 2009-2010.

6 SECTION 18. The legislature determines that there is in  
7 the deposit beverage container special fund at least \$  
8 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
9 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the deposit  
10 beverage container special fund to the general fund the sum of  
11 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
12 year 2009-2010.

13 SECTION 19. The legislature determines that there is in  
14 the tobacco settlement special fund at least \$ in  
15 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
16 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the tobacco  
17 settlement special fund to the general fund the sum of  
18 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
19 year 2009-2010.

20 SECTION 20. The legislature determines that there is in  
21 the neurotrauma special fund at least \$ in excess of  
22 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of

1 finance is authorized to transfer from the neurotrauma special  
2 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

4 SECTION 21. The legislature determines that there is in  
5 the noise, radiation, and indoor air quality special fund at  
6 least \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund. On  
7 July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to transfer  
8 from the noise, radiation, and indoor air quality special fund  
9 to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

11 SECTION 22. The legislature determines that there is in  
12 the environmental health education fund at least \$ in  
13 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
14 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the  
15 environmental health education fund to the general fund the sum  
16 of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
17 year 2009-2010.

18 SECTION 23. The legislature determines that there is in  
19 the emergency medical services special fund at least \$  
20 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
21 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the emergency  
22 medical services special fund to the general fund the sum of

1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
2 year 2009-2010.

3 SECTION 24. The legislature determines that there is in  
4 the vital statistics improvement special fund at least  
5 \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund. On  
6 July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to transfer  
7 from the vital statistics improvement special fund to the  
8 general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be  
9 necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

10 SECTION 25. The legislature determines that there is in  
11 the clean air special fund at least \$ in excess of the  
12 requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
13 finance is authorized to transfer from the clean air special  
14 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

16 SECTION 26. The legislature determines that there is in  
17 the environmental management special fund at least \$  
18 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
19 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the  
20 environmental management special fund to the general fund the  
21 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
22 fiscal year 2009-2010.



1 SECTION 27. The legislature determines that there is in  
2 the environmental response revolving fund at least \$  
3 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
4 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the  
5 environmental response revolving fund to the general fund the  
6 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
7 fiscal year 2009-2010.

8 SECTION 28. The legislature determines that there is in  
9 the driver education and training fund at least \$ in  
10 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
11 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the driver  
12 education and training fund to the general fund the sum of  
13 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
14 year 2009-2010.

15 SECTION 29. The legislature determines that there is in  
16 the judiciary computer system special fund at least \$  
17 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
18 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the judiciary  
19 computer system special fund to the general fund the sum of  
20 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
21 year 2009-2010.

1 SECTION 30. The legislature determines that there is in  
2 the preservation of endangered plants fund at least \$  
3 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
4 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the  
5 preservation of endangered plants fund to the general fund the  
6 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
7 fiscal year 2009-2010.

8 SECTION 31. The legislature determines that there is in  
9 the special land and development fund at least \$ in  
10 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
11 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the special  
12 land and development fund to the general fund the sum of  
13 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
14 year 2009-2010.

15 SECTION 32. The legislature determines that there is in  
16 the natural area reserve fund at least \$ in excess of  
17 the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
18 finance is authorized to transfer from the natural area reserve  
19 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

21 SECTION 33. The legislature determines that there is in  
22 the land conservation fund at least \$ in excess of the

1 requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director of  
2 finance is authorized to transfer from the land conservation  
3 fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

5 SECTION 34. The legislature determines that there is in  
6 the Salvinia Molesta removal fund at least \$ in excess  
7 of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director  
8 of finance is authorized to transfer from the Salvinia Molesta  
9 removal fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so  
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

11 SECTION 35. The legislature determines that there is in  
12 the beach restoration special fund at least \$ in  
13 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
14 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the beach  
15 restoration special fund to the general fund the sum of  
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
17 year 2009-2010.

18 SECTION 36. The legislature determines that there is in  
19 the university revenue-undertakings fund at least \$ in  
20 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
21 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the  
22 university revenue-undertakings fund to the general fund the sum

1 of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
2 year 2009-2010.

3 SECTION 37. The legislature determines that there is in  
4 the Hawaii cancer research special fund at least \$ in  
5 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
6 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the Hawaii  
7 cancer research special fund to the general fund the sum of  
8 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
9 year 2009-2010.

10 SECTION 38. The legislature determines that there is in  
11 the tuition and fees special fund at least \$ in excess  
12 of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the director  
13 of finance is authorized to transfer from the tuition and fees  
14 special fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so  
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

16 SECTION 39. The legislature determines that there is in  
17 the university of Hawaii housing assistance revolving fund at  
18 least \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund. On  
19 July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to transfer  
20 from the university of Hawaii housing assistance revolving fund  
21 to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

1 SECTION 40. The legislature determines that there is in  
2 the systemwide information technology and services special fund  
3 at least \$ in excess of the requirements of the fund.  
4 On July 1, 2009, the director of finance is authorized to  
5 transfer from the systemwide information technology and services  
6 special fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so  
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

8 SECTION 41. The legislature determines that there is in  
9 the research and training revolving fund at least \$ in  
10 excess of the requirements of the fund. On July 1, 2009, the  
11 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the research  
12 and training revolving fund to the general fund the sum of  
13 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
14 year 2009-2010.

15 SECTION 42. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
