SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO
REQUIRE ALL MOTOR VEHICLES TO USE THEIR HEADLIGHTS WHILE
DRIVING IN THE CAPITOL'S PARKING STRUCTURE.

1 WHEREAS, the State Capitol parking structure is an area of
2 high traffic for both motor vehicles and pedestrians; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the parking structure is located underground and
5 devoid of natural sunlight; and
6

7 WHEREAS, the parking structure's lighting has been reduced
8 as a means of saving energy; and
9

10 WHEREAS, every year there are more than 600 traffic
11 accidents involving pedestrians in Hawaii; and
12

13 WHEREAS, there have been several "close calls" in the past
14 in which pedestrians were nearly struck by motor vehicles due to
15 the parking structure's poor lighting; and
16

17 WHEREAS, parking structures are notorious for being safety
18 hazards, creating a need for precautions to ensure the safety of
19 the parking structure's occupants; and
20

21 WHEREAS, requiring all motor vehicles to use their
22 headlights while driving in the capitol's parking structure
23 could prevent a tragic accident from happening on State
24 property; now, therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2009,
28 that the Department of Accounting and General Services is urged
29 to require all motor vehicles to use their headlights while
30 driving in the capitol's parking structure; and

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
33 Resolution be transmitted to the Department of Accounting and
34 General Services.
