Your Committee received testimony in support of this nominee from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. A written statement and resume was received from the nominee. Written testimony presented to the Committee may be reviewed on the Legislature's website.


Your Committee finds that this nominee for reappointment to the Board of Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, and Landscape Architects is one of two landscape architects on the Board and, as such, represents a valuable perspective on the Board. Your Committee finds that this nominee frequently attends national meetings of landscape architects and brings that information back to the Board. However, your Committee also notes that this nominee has a sporadic attendance record at Board meetings and, despite living on Oahu, did not attend either of the hearings that your Committee scheduled to hear this nomination. Your Committee finds that this nominee's professional background and experience are valuable to the Board, but also finds that members' commitment and active participation is critical for the



successful fulfillment of the Board's advisory and regulatory functions.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection that is attached to this report, your Committee, after full consideration of the background, experience, and qualifications of the nominee, has found the nominee to be qualified for the position to which nominated and recommends that the Senate advise and consent to the nomination.
