The purpose of this bill is to increase bicycle and moped registration fees from \$15 to \$25.


A concerned individual testified in opposition to this bill.

Increasing bicycle fees may be a means of generating additional revenues that can be used to improve bicycling facilities and conditions statewide that can make bicycling a viable alternative mode of transportation in Hawaii.
