Your Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs,
to which was referred H.B. No. 946 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE
AND THE ARTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to establish a state income-tax
check-off for the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts
(SFCA).

The SFCA, Hawaii Arts Alliance, and several concerned
individuals testified in support of this measure. The Department
of Taxation and Department of Accounting and General Services
opposed the bill. The Tax Foundation of Hawaii and Holualoa
Foundation for Arts and Culture provided comments.

Your Committee amended this bill by inserting an effective
date of July 1, 2112 to encourage further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs that is
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the
intent and purpose of H.B. No. 946, as amended herein, and
recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto
as H.B. No. 946, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on
Finance.
