Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 150 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT OF THE
UNITED STATES AND THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ADOPT THE
UNITED NATIONS DECLARATION ON THE RIGHTS OF INDIGENOUS
PEOPLES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to preserve and
maintain the rights of the kanaka maoli, the indigenous people of
Hawaii, by urging the President of the United States and the
United States Congress to adopt the United Nations Declaration on
the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.

The Hawaiian Political Action Council of Hawaii, Japanese
American Citizens League-Honolulu Chapter, and a concerned
individual supported this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No.
150 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on
Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs.
