Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred  
H.C.R. No. 166 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF  
HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE BERNICE PAUAHI  
BISHOP MUSEUM TO DEVELOP A PLAN TO IMPLEMENT REPLICAS OF  
HAWAIIAN HALE ON THE STATE CAPITOL LAWN SURROUNDED BY  
TROPICAL FOLIAGE FOR REST AREAS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to enrich the  
experience of visitors to the Hawaii State Capitol by requesting  
the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, with the assistance of the Bernice  
Pauahi Bishop Museum, to develop a plan to build replicas of  
Hawaiian hale surrounded by appropriate tropical foliage on the  
State Capitol lawn to serve as visitor rest areas.

The Representative of the 11<sup>th</sup> District supported this  
measure. The Office of Hawaiian Affairs supported the intent of  
this measure. Several individuals opposed this measure.

Your Committee requests the Department of Land and Natural  
Resources to consider funding this worthy project.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,  
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No.  
166 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on  
Finance.
