H.C.R. No. 185 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE  
GOVERNOR TO CONVENE A SCENIC BYWAYS WORKING GROUP TO SELECT  
POSSIBLE SITES STATEWIDE, INCLUDING THE PI`ILANI TRAIL ON
