Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 94 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO
CONDUCT A MANAGEMENT AND FINANCIAL AUDIT OF THE HAWAII PUBLIC
HOUSING AUTHORITY'S MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the
auditor to conduct a management and financial audit of the Hawaii
Public Housing Authority's maintenance contracts.

The Hawaii Public Housing Authority submitted testimony in
opposition of this measure.

Your Committee finds that there are many longstanding
problems in two of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's public
housing properties. Some of these problems include: disabled or
missing fire alarms, corroded garbage chutes, pest infestations,
elevators in a continual state of disrepair, and lack of
compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act.
Although your Committee acknowledges that the Hawaii Public
Housing Authority has embarked on a "turnaround plan" to address
some of these maintenance problems at public housing facilities
statewide, your Committee believes that an audit is necessary to
ensure improved ongoing maintenance of these facilities.


