Your Committee on Economic Revitalization, Business, & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.R. No. 26 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO ISSUE POSTAL STAMPS HONORING THE WORLD WAR II JAPANESE-AMERICAN NISEI SOLDIERS, OTHER DISTINGUISHED MILITARY UNITS IN UNITED STATES HISTORY, AND AMERICANS WHO FOUGHT AGAINST DISCRIMINATION BASED ON RACE OR NATIONAL ORIGIN,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to urge the United States Postal Service to issue stamps honoring World War II Japanese-American Nisei soldiers, other distinguished United States military units, and Americans who fought against discrimination based on race or national origin.
