Your Committee on Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 936
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
CERTIFICATES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the requirement for the
Department of Health (DOH) to issue a sanitation certificate to
qualify for a county business license for the operation of a
lodging or tenement house, group home, group residence, group
living arrangement, hotel, or boarding house. County business
licenses are no longer issued for such businesses so the
requirement for a sanitation certificate is not necessary.


DOH and a concerned individual supported this bill.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 936
and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the
Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
