S.C.R. No. 127 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT OF THE  
UNITED STATES AND THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ADOPT THE  
UNITED NATIONS DECLARATION ON THE RIGHTS OF INDIGENOUS  
PEOPLES,"

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to help promote  
and protect the rights of indigenous peoples, including native  
Hawaiians, by urging the President of the United States and the  
United States Congress to adopt the United Nations Declaration on  
the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.

The Hawaiian Political Action Council of Hawaii and several  
concerned individuals supported this concurrent resolution.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,  
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No.  
127 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on  
Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs.
