The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to recognize the

commemorative stamp in his honor.

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs and Friends of Iolani Palace
supported this concurrent resolution. The Hawaiian Political
Action Council of Hawaii and several concerned individuals opposed
this concurrent resolution.

While the issuance of a commemorative stamp would help
educate others about one of the many great leaders Hawaii has
given rise to, your Committee acknowledges the concerns of several
testifiers that to do so may perpetuate the past and future
Americanization of Hawaiian culture.
