RELATING TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

Allows a tenant who is a victim of domestic violence, sexual abuse, or harassment by stalking to terminate his or her rental agreement. (HB812 HD1)

RELATING TO HEALTH.

Makes amendments to clarify the support and expansion of new technology in the use of telemedicine; clarifies that telehealth is within the scope of a physician's practice.

RELATING TO DENTISTRY.

Grants the Board of Dental Examiners the power to issue cease and desist orders for the unlicensed practice of dentistry. (HB1213 HD1)

RELATING TO LABELING OF MEAT AND FISH PRODUCTS.  
Requires truthful labeling of meat and fish that has been gas-treated.

HB 233  
Status

RELATING TO THE MORTGAGE RESCUE FRAUD  
PREVENTION ACT.  
Excludes licensed real estate brokers and salespersons from the  
definition of distressed property consultants in the Mortgage  
Foreclosure Rescue Fraud Prevention Act. Prohibits certain conduct  
relating to the acquisition of an ownership interest in distressed  
property by licensed real estate brokers and salespersons.




Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
