<u>SB 205, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1282)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO OWNER-BUILDERS. Requires applicants for county building permits under the owner-builder exemption from the contractor licensing law to submit their state and federal tax identification numbers, federal and state tax clearances, and certificate of workers' compensation insurance. (SB205 HD1)	EBM, CPC/JUD
<u>SB 300, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1179)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Requires class 5 dispenser liquor licensees to carry liability insurance as a condition of acquiring, transferring, and renewing a license. (SB300 HD1)	EBM, CPC/JUD
<u>SB 58, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1111)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE. Creates a driver exclusion endorsement to enable a named insured to exclude specified persons from being covered under a policy. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB58 HD1)	TRN, CPC/JUD

Status

RELATING TO INSURANCE.
Amends Act 177, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008 (Life Settlements Model Act) by repealing the requirement that the insurance commissioner report annually to the legislature on the implementation and effects of Act 177 and by making the Act permanent.

Status

RELATING TO DENTISTS.
Authorizes the board of dental examiners to sanction licensees for false or misleading advertising.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


