| <u>HB 254</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES. Requires the public utilities commission to treat switched access phone service as fully competitive. | CPC |
| <u>HB 627</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO CONTRACTORS. Prohibits the resumption of work for any person who is issued a citation for operating without a contractor's license in good standing until a hearing is conducted, and makes the issuance of citations and cease and desist orders mandatory. Amends penalties. | CPC, JUD |
| <u>HB 239</u> <u>Status</u> | RELATING TO INSURANCE. Repeals the statute that limits insurance coverage for punitive damages to contracts that specifically provide such coverage. | CPC, JUD |
