SB 205, SD1RELATING TO OWNER-BUILDERS.EBM, CPC/JUD(SSCR521)Increases period prohibiting sale or lease by owner-builder from 1 to 2years unless due to circumstances beyond control of the owner or<br/>lessee as determined by the contractors licensing board; requires that<br/>an exemption from licensing requirements is given no more than once<br/>in 3 years; clarifies violation provisions. (SD1)EBM, CPC/JUD
