<a href="#"><u>Testimony</u></a>	Requires the department of education to ensure that all traffic safety measures are in place and operational prior to the opening of a newly constructed public or charter school. Requires the same of private schools.

<a href="#"><u>SB 735</u></a>	RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.	EDH/TIA, WTL
<a href="#"><u>Testimony</u></a>	Requires the counties to identify and designate affordable housing receiving zones to facilitate the development of affordable housing.

<a href="#"><u>SB 737</u></a>	RELATING TO HOUSING.	EDH/TIA, WTL
<a href="#"><u>Testimony</u></a>	Authorizes mixed-use housing projects and infrastructure projects that are associated with a housing or mixed-use housing project to be eligible for the expedited review process currently offered to qualifying housing projects.

<a href="#"><u>SB 740</u></a>	RELATING TO HOUSING.	TIA/EDH, WTL
<a href="#"><u>Testimony</u></a>	Directs the department of land and natural resources and Hawaii housing finance and development corporation (HHFDC) to identify public lands within one-half mile of the city's transit corridor and within a one-mile radius of any designated transit station suitable for affordable housing. Requires governor to set aside the identified public lands for housing development. Requires the HHFDC to report to legislature.
