SB 188 Testimony	RELATING TO HOUSING. Requires a percentage of state conveyance and excise taxes to be paid into the rental housing trust fund.	EDH, WAM
SB 442 Testimony	RELATING TO TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT. Authorizes the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation to grant funds to affordable housing developers to contract for third-party review and certification to expedite the process and issuance of building permits for an affordable housing project that is part of a transit oriented development; appropriates moneys for the grants. SB 496 Testimony	RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. Clarifies the functions, duties, and roles of the charter school review panel in the administration and operation of charter schools, and improves fiscal and budgetary accountability. SB 733 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO EDUCATION.</u> <u>Clarifies the law for determining school impact fees for financing new or expanding existing DOE schools or facilities.</u>	<u>EDH, WAM</u> <u>[Measure added on 02-17-09]</u>
