HB 1648 Status	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Provides parents of children with disabilities with additional flexibility in choices relating to education.	EDN, HLT FIN
HB 1688 Status	RELATING TO INCOME TAX CHECK-OFF Increases the school-level minor repairs and maintenance and the libraries income tax check-off provisions from \$2 to \$5.	EDN, FIN
