
<u>SB 1671, SD1</u> (SSCR739) Status	RELATING TO FOSSIL FUELS. Prohibits the approval of any new electricity generating facilities using fossil fuel and the modification of existing electricity generating facilities to allow the use of more fossil fuel. (SD1)	EEP, CPC, FIN
<u>SB 243</u> (SSCR725) Status	RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM. Requires retail dealers with more than seventy-five thousand square feet of retail space to operate redemption centers. Effective 10/1/2009.	EEP, EBM, FIN
<u>SB 1173, SD2</u> (SSCR809) Status	RELATING TO ENERGY EFFICIENCY. Establishes energy-efficiency initiatives necessary for and contributing to the transition of Hawaii's energy sector to non-petroleum energy sources. Effective 01/01/90. (SD2)	EEP/WLO, CPC, FIN


