<u>SB 1008, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR576)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO WATER QUALITY STANDARDS. Amends state water quality standards for inland and marine waters to conform to federal standards. (SD1)	EEP/WLO, FIN
<u>SB 266, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR643)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO GLOBAL WARMING. Establishes the global warming task force to assess the impacts of global warming and climate change trends in the State. (SD2)	EEP, FIN


