Clarifies that individuals hired after June 30, 2008, may be employed  
on an emergency basis, for no more than three years in the aggregate.  
Clarifies that individuals hired after June 30, 1997, but before July 1,  
2008, may be employed on an emergency basis, for no more than four  
years in the aggregate.


