Status

RELATING TO LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE STATE.

Requires majority vote of the legislature or two-thirds vote of house or senate to disapprove the sale or exchange of state-held lands to nonstate entities or persons; requires community briefing where land

located prior to sale or exchange.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
