<u>SB 1096, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR655)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY WORKFORCE AND DEVELOPMENT. Appropriates funds for science-, technology-, engineering-, and math-related programs and K-12 creative media education programs. (SD2)	HED/EDN, FIN
<u>SB 1129, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR562)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ATHLETIC TRAINERS. Requires athletic trainers to register with the department of commerce and consumer affairs. (SD1)	HED/EDN, CPC, FIN
<u>SB 39</u> <u>(SSCR608)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO REPORTS ON THE HAWAII CANCER RESEARCH SPECIAL FUND. Beginning 01/01/2010, requires the University of Hawaii to report semi-annually on the moneys in the Hawaii cancer research special fund, including deposits, expenditures, and other transactions.	HED, FIN



SB 1046, SD1
(SSCR797)
Status RELATING TO HEALTH PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION. HED, HLT, FIN
Appropriates funds to support the Hawaii Quentin Burdick rural health interdisciplinary training program. (SD1)

SB 1674, SD2
(SSCR664)
Status RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. HED, FIN
Authorizes the University of Hawaii board of regents to issue revenue bonds to finance the costs of construction or maintenance of capital improvement projects; appropriates moneys from the revenue bond proceeds for fiscal year 2008-09 and fiscal year 2009-10, with unexpended and unencumbered balances to lapse to the general fund on June 30, 2013 and June 30, 2015, respectively. SB 1311, SD1
(SSCR731)
Status RELATING TO AQUATIC RESOURCES. HED, WLO
Exempts UH from permitting or application requirements when carrying out repair and maintenance relating to the Hawaii marine laboratory refuge. (SD1)


