<u>HB 8</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Bases University of Hawaii general funding on a student-weighted formula.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 85</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LEEWARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE. Makes an appropriation for the planning, design, and construction for a second access road for leeward community college.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 123</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Authorizes the board of regents of the University of Hawaii to issue additional revenue bonds in the principal amount of \$150,000,000 for the purpose of financing the costs of construction or maintenance of capital improvement projects constituting university projects. Appropriates the proceeds of the initial \$100,000,000 of the revenue bonds (as authorized by Act 161, SLH 2007), in the current fiscal year and any of the fiscal years thereafter, to and including fiscal year 2012-2013. Appropriates the proceeds of the additional \$150,000,000 in the current fiscal year and any of the fiscal years thereafter, to and including fiscal year 2014-2015.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 124</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION. Appropriates funds to support the Hawaii Quentin Burdick rural health interdisciplinary training program.	HED, HLT, FIN
<u>HB 132</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO QUALIFIED TUITION PROGRAMS. Provides an annual maximum deduction of \$5,000 per individual or \$10,000 for a married couple filing jointly for contributions made to a section 529 qualified tuition program in 2009 and thereafter.	HED, FIN


