**The following Informational Briefing has been cancelled.**

The purpose of this informational briefing is to review impending significant reductions to the Department of Human Services necessary to address the state's fiscal shortfall. The Senate and House Committees on Human Services will be working with the Administration to remain committed to positive outcomes for children and youth in low-income households, ensuring more children are enrolled in no-cost or low-cost human service programs, better linking the needs of the state's seniors and persons with disabilities with the appropriate services, protecting the most vulnerable in our communities and addressing the growing number of unemployed with employment training programs.

The subject of layoffs, reduction in work days, and wage reduction of DHS employees will be discussed.

The following organizations have been invited to participate:

A representative from Easter Seals; and

A representative from PHOCUSED; and

The Director of the Department of Human Services or her designee.

Persons wishing to offer written comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.


