Requires the dismissal of a protest of an award of a contract if the reason for the protest is based upon an error in a bid that is less than 1% of the bid amount. Limits the protested amount in an administrative proceeding to no less than 10% of the total estimated value of the contract. Requires the initiator of an administrative proceeding to pay a cash or protest bond equal to 1% of the total estimated value of the contract and not more than \$50,000. (HD1)	JGO
