<u>HB 685</u> Status	RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE COUNCIL. Establishes full-time equivalent staff positions for the state fire council to accomplish its duties and responsibilities.	PBS/LAB, FIN
<u>HB 941</u> Status	RELATING TO ELECTRIC GUNS. Permits county departments of liquor control investigators to possess electric guns. Defines "county liquor authorities" and "law enforcement officers".	PBS/LAB, JUD
<u>HB 231</u> Status	RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES. Requires the department of public safety to report to the legislature any inmate or correctional facility employee death within 24 hours.	PBS, FIN

RELATING TO A FIRE SPRINKLER TAX DEDUCTION.  
Provides an income tax deduction to residential unit owner occupants for qualifying costs of installation of an automatic fire sprinkler system installed after 12/31/09.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
