SB 586 Testimony	RELATING TO HIGHWAYS. Allows medium-speed electric vehicles to be operated on roads with a posted speed limit of 45 miles per hour or less.	TIA
SB 735 Testimony	RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING. Requires the counties to identify and designate affordable housing receiving zones to facilitate the development of affordable housing.	EDH/TIA, WTL
SB 740 Testimony	RELATING TO HOUSING. Directs the department of land and natural resources and Hawaii housing finance and development corporation (HHFDC) to identify public lands within one-half mile of the city's transit corridor and within a one-mile radius of any designated transit station suitable for affordable housing. Requires governor to set aside the identified public lands for housing development. Requires the HHFDC to report to legislature. (Measured added were Deferred from Wednesday, February 11, 2009)	TIA/EDH, WTL
SB 1613 Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. Allows the department of transportation to impose upon private parties using state harbors and airports the duty to defend, hold harmless, and indemnify.	TIA, JGO [Measured added 02/12/09]
SB 1224 Testimony	RELATING TO AIRPORT CONCESSIONS. Allows for certain adjustments and modifications to airport concession leases.	TIA, WAM [Measured added 02/12/09]
SB 1064 Testimony	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY. Prohibits the sale of new and unused tires that were manufactured more than six years prior to the date of the sale.	TIA, JGO [Measured added 02/12/09]

SB 300 Testimony	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Requires liquor licenses to carry liability insurance as a condition of acquiring and renewing a license. Requires liquor liability insurers to notify the county liquor commissions upon a termination, rejection, or nonrenewal of a licensee's coverage.	TIA, CPN [Measured added 02/12/09]

SB 1053 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW.</u> <u>Allows an agency to transfer the responsibility for preparing and funding environmental assessments and environmental impact statements to the user of the state or county land or new improvements to be constructed with state or county funds necessary to accommodate the user's operations.</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, WAM</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 701 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO LANDFILLS.</u> <u>Places a moratorium on any new municipal solid waste landfill units on the leeward coast on or after 8/1/09.</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, WTL</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 1635 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO WASTE MANAGEMENT.</u> <u>Requires all waste facilities to charge commercial haulers operating commercial vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of 19,500 pounds or less, a tipping fee calculated on a pass through basis only.</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, WAM</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 989 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.</u> <u>Extends the sunset date of Act 2, Second Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, from the forty-fifth day following adjournment sine die of the Regular Session of 2009 to the forty-fifth day following adjournment sine die of the Regular Session of 2010.</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, JGO</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 1612 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION ENERGY.</u> <u>Establishes a comprehensive approach to increasing the use of alternative fuel vehicles in the State, including state procurement of alternative fuel vehicles, tax incentives, and infrastructure requirements</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, WAM</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 719 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO TAXATION.</u> <u>Authorizes an additional general excise tax on sale proceeds of vehicles having a net weight over a specified amount and provides a general excise tax exemption for the purchase of passenger vehicles or light trucks that operate on clean fuels. Establishes a clean vehicle special fund.</u>	<u>ENE/TIA, WAM</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
SB 1202 Testimony	<u>RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION ENERGY INITIATIVES.</u> <u>Establishes the development of non-fossil fuel transportation as a state policy goal. Provides tax credits for the purchase and installation of electric vehicle charging infrastructure and alternative fuel refueling infrastructure. Requires the designation of parking spaces for electric vehicles. Requires state and county agencies to follow a priority list when purchasing energy-efficient vehicles, including electric vehicles. Requires the director of transportation to furnish information to the energy resources coordinator on the use of electric vehicles in the State. Requires the department of transportation to develop a plan for electric vehicle infrastructure.</u>	<u>TIA/ENE, WAM</u> <u>[Measured added</u> <u>02/12/09]</u>
