SB 1272	RELATING TO TAXATION.	TSM, WAM
Testimony	Amends the transient accommodations tax to require that the first

special fund and subsequently allotted among specific funds.

SB 222 RELATING TO TOURISM. PSM/TSM, WAM

Testimony Appropriates funds for the application of a spaceport license from the Federal Aviation Administration to establish space tourism in Hawaii.

RELATING TO TOURISM EMERGENCY. SB 271 TSM, WAM

Testimony Adds a national or global economic crisis to situations considered a

tourism emergency. Requires, in addition to the governor's declaration

of the existence of a tourism emergency, the governor's express

approval and direction before action may be taken.
