Allows 999-year homestead leases to be assigned to land trusts that are created for purposes of managing and holding the homestead leasehold

estate for the benefit of the lessee and lessee's family members.

HB 791

RELATING TO COUNTIES.

HUS, WLO

(HSCR200) Status Renders void as against public policy any county ordinance that prohibits a group living facility for the elderly and persons with disabilities from being located within any specified distance from

another group living facility.
