SB 721 (SSCR482) Status

RELATING TO DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS.

WLO, FIN

Changes the authority of the Hawaii Community Development Authority to assess the costs of providing public facilities against real property in the community development district from mandatory to

discretionary.
