The following measure(s) were previously heard on **February 11, 2009**.

<u>HB 948</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO KAKAAKO. Increases the reserved housing requirement for a planned development to twenty-five per cent of floor space in the Kakaako community development district, mauka area for lots three acres or more in size.	WLO/HSG
<u>HB 1532</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO KAKAAKO. Increases the reserved housing requirement for a major development on a lot of at least 1 acre in the Kakaako community development district, mauka area.	WLO/HSG
<u>HB 1189</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HOUSING. Requires petitioners for reclassification of district boundaries and developers of 25 or more housing units provide for at least 60% of the units to be affordable housing, of which 25% going to the households earning up to 80% of the area median income.	HSG/WLO


