<u>HB 1492</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii for a study relating to beach erosion at Kailua beach.	WLO, HED, FIN
<u>HB 1543</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds to a task force attached to the University of Hawaii school of ocean and earth science and technology to provide recommendations to prevent, mitigate, and reverse beach erosion at Kailua beach. <u>HB 1808</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO COASTAL AREAS. Requires maintenance of public beach accesses by adjacent landowners and imposes penalties for noncompliance. RELATING TO SHORELINE SETBACKS.
Directs BLNR to adopt rules for determining the shoreline setback and mauka extent of the conservation district for Kailua beach; establishes an interim coastal construction setback line.

RELATING TO SHORELINE MANAGEMENT
Establishes the shoreline management task force to create uniform statewide management standards of shoreline areas.
