Status

RELATING TO UNENCUMBERED PUBLIC LANDS.  
Requires the department of land and natural resources to establish a simple permit process for wedding ceremonies at state beaches and parks.

HB 1310  
Status

RELATING TO OCEAN RECREATION.  
Deletes: (i) prohibition of commercial operation of thrill craft, water sledding, parasailing, or high speed boating in Maunaloa Bay, Oahu, on weekends and holidays; (ii) requirement that permits be issued at public auction; and (iii) maximum term of permit issue of 20 years.

Status

RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY.  
Permits the registrar of the bureau of conveyances to accept electronic documents with electronic signatures for recording.


