
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Upon receipt of federal funds allocated by
2 the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. 111-
3 5, or other federal stimulus acts, there is appropriated out of
4 these funds the sum of \$1 so much thereof as may be necessary
5 for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the same sum or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 to fund the following
7 department of health programs and services:

9	(2) Respite services	\$1
10	(3) Substance abuse treatment	\$1
11	(4) Early intervention services	\$1

2 (b) Upon receipt of federal funds allocated by the

3 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. 111-5,

4 or other federal stimulus acts, there is appropriated out of

5 these funds the sum of \$1 so much thereof as may be necessary

6 for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the same sum or so much thereof as

7 may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 to fund the following

8 department of human service programs and services:

9 (1) Increased medicaid reimbursements \$1

10 (2) Disproportionate share hospital payments \$1

11 (3) Hawaii children's health care program \$1

12 (4) Domestic violence services \$1

13 (5) Adult dental services \$1

14 (6) Immigrant Health Initiative program \$1

16 (8) Medicaid budget to cover the expected

18 (c) The sums appropriated shall be expended by the

19 department of health and the department of human services for

20 the purposes of this Act; provided that the level of general

21 funds appropriated in fiscal year 2008-2009, for the programs

1 identified in this Act shall not in fiscal years 2009-2010 and
2 2010-2011, be:

3 (1) Replaced by the federal funds appropriated by this
4 Act; or

5 (2) Decreased because of the availability of the federal
6 funds appropriated by this Act;

7 provided further that the governor may approve the expenditure
8 of federal funds in excess of levels authorized by the
9 legislature only in the event that the expenditure is made for
10 the benefit of the public.

11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
