
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The civil defense division of the state
2 department of defense shall conduct a study to determine the
3 feasibility of allowing the facilities at Lualualei on the
4 island of Oahu, which are owned by the United States Navy, to be
5 used as an emergency shelter for civilians.

6 (b) The feasibility study shall examine:

- 7 (1) Any necessary agreements between the State and the
8 United States Navy;
- 9 (2) The sufficiency and capacity of the facilities to
10 provide emergency shelter;
- 11 (3) Logistical challenges to making all or part of the
12 facilities available to civilians for use during an
13 emergency;
- 14 (4) Any costs involved; and
- 15 (5) Any other pertinent issues.

16 SECTION 2. The civil defense division shall submit a
17 report of its findings, including any proposed legislation, to



1 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
2 of the regular session of 2010.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
