## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:

5    1. To be expended by the department of education:

6           A. Kamaile elementary school, Oahu  
7               Plans, design and construction for  
8               air conditioning for the school.

16 for federal aid financing and/or

17 reimbursement.
